#### What is it?

- Full-featured hardware & software diagnostic/repair utility for Mac OS X
- Made by Micromat, makers of Drive 10



- Everything Norton Utilities ever did, and much more (and much better).
  - Symantec just discontinued Norton Utilities for Macintosh.
  - Will continue to support current customers and release updates for 10.3, but will not update when 10.4 comes out.



- Tests nearly every hardware component of your Mac.
- Verifies and repairs file and volume structures.
- Surface-scans your entire HD.



- Rebuilds disk directories
  - Not sure yet if it's comparable to DiskWarrior
- Defragments disks
  - Using the same tools as Drive 10



- Creates a bootable partition ("eDrive") for emergencies.
- Recovers data
- Secure-deletes data



- Helps calibrate monitors and check LCDs for dead pixels.
- Helps check your Mac's audio output.



- Can automatically test:
  - Disk directories
  - SMART diagnostics
- Can automatically back up disk directories to help recover deleted files.
- Alerts you via email if problems arise.



## What does it cost?

- \$97.97 for new users
- \$59.97 for upgrades from v. 2 or 3
- \$59.97 for a Norton "cross-grade"
